目的 (300 字以上)	《WSSO 零毁林制品合规性评价技术要求》标准为通过统一的全球性规范，协调各国行动，系统性解决森林破坏问题，促进国际贸易与环境保护的平衡发展。统一全球规则，减少贸易摩擦，消除标准碎片化：不同国家或区域（如欧盟、美国）的零毁林法规存在差异，可为全球企业提供统一的技术门槛（如原产地验证方法、森林退化定义），降低跨境贸易的合规复杂性。避免重复认证：通过国际互认的认证体系，减少企业为满足多国法规而重复提交数据或接受审核的成本。保护全球生态与气候，量化森林保护目标：将森林覆盖率、碳储量变化等指标纳入国际标准，直接支持《巴黎协定》和“昆明-蒙特利尔全球生物多样性框架”的实施。保护跨境生态系统：针对跨国森林区，制定区域性技术规范，协调多国行动避免“竞相逐底”。		

范围	技术层面：供应链追溯技术规范包括：地理信息采集、数据链整合、土地用途变化监测；风险评估工具包括：毁林风险模型、碳核算方法；验证与认证技术：第三方审核技术规范、辅助筛查。 管理层面：合规流程管理包括：尽职调查程序、文档管理标准；责任划分与追责机制包括：主体责任界定、违规处罚标准。 对象范围：适用于进出欧盟的大豆、棕榈油、牛肉、木材、可可、咖啡、橡胶及其衍生品（如皮革、巧克力、家具、纸张）。 区域适配：包括全球各国家进口和出口欧盟国家的全部适应对象产品。

Purpose (More than 300 words)	The WSSO Technical Requirements for Compliance Assessment of Zero Deforestation Products standard is designed to coordinate the actions of all countries through unified global norms to systematically solve the problem of forest destruction and promote the balanced development of international trade and environmental protection. Unify global rules, reduce trade friction and eliminate fragmentation of standards: There are		

	differences in zero-deforestation regulations in different countries or regions (e.g., EU, U.S.), and the international standard can provide global enterprises with unified technical thresholds (e.g., origin verification methods, forest degradation definitions), reducing the compliance complexity of cross-border trade. Avoid duplicate certifications: Reduce the cost of companies submitting data or undergoing audits repeatedly to meet multi-country regulations through an internationally recognized certification system. Protect global ecology and climate, and quantify forest protection targets: Incorporate indicators such as forest cover and carbon stock changes into international standards, directly supporting the implementation of the Paris Agreement and the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework. Protecting transboundary ecosystems: Developing regional technical specifications for transboundary forest areas and coordinating multinational actions to avoid 'race to the bottom' .
Scope	• Technical level: supply chain traceability technical specifications include: geographic information collection, data chain integration, land use change monitoring; risk assessment tools include: deforestation risk model, carbon accounting methodology; validation and certification techniques: third-party auditing technical specifications, assisted screening. • Management level: Compliance process management includes: due diligence procedures, document management standards; responsibility division and accountability mechanism includes: definition of the main responsibility, penalty standards for non-compliance. • Scope of Objects: Applicable to soybean, palm oil, beef, timber, cocoa, coffee, rubber and its derivatives (e.g. leather, chocolate, furniture, paper) entering and leaving the EU. • Regional Adaptation: Includes all adapted subject products imported into and exported from EU countries by countries around the globe.
